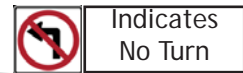
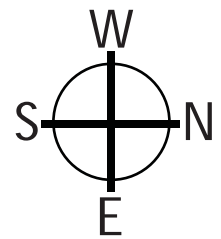




# What's Happening In My Area?



## Bangerter Highway

Traffic between 3200 West and Bangerter is split, with two westbound lanes on the north and two eastbound lanes on the south side of 3500 South.

# Nov. 4, 2009

## 3600 West

- 3600 West: left-turns are open from east and westbound 3500 S. to 3600 W.; and closed from north and southbound 3600 W. to 3500 S.

- 3450 West: left-turns are closed from east and westbound 3500 South and opened from north and southbound 3450 West.

- Crews are almost finished installing concrete curbing in the middle of 3500 South between 3200 West and 3600 West for the UTA Bus Rapid Transit Lane.



## 3450 West

## 3200 West

- 3200 West: left-turns are closed in all directions at the 3200 W. intersection.

- Crews will begin concrete curbing for the UTA Bus Rapid Transit Lane between 3200 West and 2700 West this week.

- Striping begins today on north side of 3500 South between 3200 West and 2700 West.

- Concrete barriers will be removed, reversible lanes will be discontinued and traffic will be split from 2700 West to 3200 West this week, providing two travel lanes in each direction.

- Market St.: left-turns are closed from westbound 3500 S. to southbound Market St.



## Market St.

## 2700 West

- 2700 West: left-turns are closed from northbound 2700 West to westbound 3500 South.

- The final quadrant at the intersection of 3500 South and 2700 West has been concrete paved and will need at least one week to cure.

- Curb and sidewalk work will take place at the intersection of 2700 West and 3500 South this week.
