Individual Section 4(f) Evaluation

Draper City, in partnership with the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT), has initiated an environmental study (a Categorical Exclusion (CE) under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA)) to study the impacts that may result from proposed improvements to the intersection of 13800 South and Bangerter Highway in Draper. Draper City intends to obtain federal funds administered by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA). The proposed action includes widening of 13800 South and Bangerter Highway to accommodate through traffic as well as dual left turn lanes onto Bangerter Highway. This project will also install sidewalks, curb-and-gutter, and updated traffic signals.

In accordance with Stipulation II, Part A and Appendix B of the *Memorandum of Understanding, State Assumption of Responsibility for Categorical Exclusions (23 USC §326)* (executed June 30, 2011), the UDOT assumes responsibility, assigned by the FHWA, for ensuring compliance with Section 4(f) of the Department of Transportation Act of 1966, as amended. In accordance with 23 CFR 774.5, UDOT is providing the Section 4(f) evaluation for this project to the Department of the Interior. A copy of both the evaluation and the draft CE are enclosed. The proposed improvements would result in a greater-than *de minimis* use of one Section 4(f) property, located at 235 E. 13800 South, Draper. This historic building would be acquired and demolished.
