

The Commission, in a meeting held November 13, 1961, approved adding to the State Road System approximately 1.2 miles of road from the junction of U-160 just south of U. S. 91 at Riverdale, southerly to the north entrance of Hill Field.

Also approved was funds as per your estimate No. 2 in the total amount of \$31,305.88 to provide temporary improvement to make this road serviceable.

The Commission acted on the assumption that Col. Nubbard, Commander of the Hill Air Force Base was requesting funds necessary to accomplish the balance of the work as per your estimate No. 1.
