COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

This **AGREEMENT**, made and entered into this 15 day of August, 2017,
by and between the **UTAH DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**, hereinafter referred to
as "**UDOT**", and **SPRINGVILLE CITY**, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Utah,
hereinafter referred to as the "**CITY**",

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the **CITY** previously installed Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB)
with pedestrian warning signs on the east and west sides of US-89 at 100 South in conjunction
with a marked pedestrian crosswalk across the north leg of the intersection; and

WHEREAS, the **CITY** plans to install another RRFB and pedestrian crossing warning sign
in the raised median on the south side of the intersection as a pedestrian crossing safety
enhancement; and

WHEREAS, the installation of the RRFB and sign requires the reconstruction of a portion of
the raised median south of the intersection; and

WHEREAS, **UDOT** has determined by formal finding that payment of said work on public
right-of-way is not in violation of the laws of the State of Utah or any legal contract with the
CITY; and

WHEREAS, this **AGREEMENT** is made to set out the terms and conditions where under
said work shall be performed.

NOW THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

1. The **CITY** will pay for all costs associated with acquiring the materials, reconstruction of the raised median, installation of the RRFB, and start-up operation of the RRFB.
2. The **UDOT** will reimburse the **CITY** for the **CITY**'s actual costs incurred for the median reconstruction and installation of the RRFB, estimated to be \$18,000.00 and not to exceed \$20,000.00. The final amount of **UDOT**'s reimbursement shall be determined upon completion of construction.
3. The **CITY** shall submit itemized bills covering the **CITY**'s actual costs incurred for the median reconstruction and RRFB installation to:

In the event there are changes in the scope of the work, extra work, or changes in the planned work covered by this agreement, a modification to this agreement in the form of a supplemental agreement, signed by representatives of the parties hereto, is required prior to the start of work on said changes.

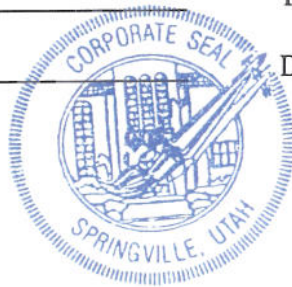

Should the CITY or the CITY's contractor or subcontractor(s) remove or damage any of UDOT's property other than what is required for project completion, the CITY, the CITY's contractor, or subcontractor(s) shall reestablish or replace those items in kind at no cost UDOT, and to UDOT's satisfaction.
