## PROJECT STATUS

**Project Design Work Resumes** - UDOT has recently given approval to resume and complete the design and environmental process for the 10th West / SR 252 reconstruction project.

**Planned Public Activities** - The project team has outlined public involvement activities shown at left that continue the format and types of communications that were conducted during the previous work on the project. Prior to beginning these events, the project team will review the public input gathered at the last round of public events as well as any input provided since that time.

**Concept Design Update** - The project team is currently evaluating the concept design presented in the public meetings last fall for possible modifications. The team will consider public issues previously expressed, commitments within the UDOT / City of Logan SR 252 Corridor Agreement and the roadway's technical needs and design standards. Key public issues being considered include;

- Traffic within the residential section of the corridor
- Pedestrian safety issues near and along 10th West
- Visually distinguishing the neighborhood area from the commercial area with the intention of improving safety for both pedestrians and drivers

**Other Environmental Issues** - The project team is also working on other issues such as wetlands, drainage and noise evaluations that are part of the environmental process and needed to complete the design. Results of these assessments and recommendations will be presented at future public events.
