

UDOT Safety Improvements at American Fork 200 East

To improve safety, UDOT consolidated the intersections of Main Street and 200 East in American Fork into a single access point because the original intersections had conflicts due to road connections at different locations and in close proximity. The changes are as follows:

200 East Area (north of Main Street)


The new intersection allows drivers on 200 East to only make a right-turn to access westbound U.S. 89. Left turns from southbound 200 East to eastbound Main Street and U.S. 89 are not allowed.

U.S. 89

Left turns are allowed from eastbound U.S. 89 to Main Street but not to northbound 200 East. Drivers will need to use an alternate route.

Main Street

Drivers traveling west on Main Street can connect to U.S. 89. UDOT extended the merge lane between 200 East and Grant Avenue to provide motorists additional space to safely merge onto U.S. 89.



This configuration also

provides safer access for pedestrians crossing 200 East at Main Street. Please use caution as drivers adjust to the new configuration.
