


# I-80 Pavement Maintenance Starts This Monday

Two-month project will include night work, freeway lane restrictions near the Salt Lake City International Airport



## OVERVIEW

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) is scheduled to perform concrete pavement maintenance on I-80 in Salt Lake City between Redwood Road and 6000 West. Maintenance work will also be completed on the freeway off-and on-ramps at 5600 West. Construction is scheduled to begin on Monday, March 14, and to be completed by May 27.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

Work is scheduled to take place seven days a week. Monday through Friday, I-80 will be reduced to two lanes during daytime hours, and to one lane each night between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. On weekends, I-80 will be reduced to one lane in each direction from Friday night at 10 p.m. to Monday morning at 6 a.m. Minor traffic delays of five minutes or less are expected during these lane restrictions. All lanes will remain open during the morning and evening commute.

Night work is scheduled on this project to keep daytime traffic moving on I-80, which sees an average of more than 60,000 cars per day. This includes activities such as jackhammering, saw cutting, and grinding, which create considerable noise and some vibration. From Wright Brothers Drive to 6000 West, night work is restricted to the hours between 7 p.m. and 10 pm.

## STAY INFORMED
