SR-209 to 3500 South

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) is constructing a project on SR-111 (Bacchus Highway) from SR-209 (New Bingham Highway) to 3500 South. The project will be constructed in two segments. The first segment, SR-209 to 8200 South, will be complete by the end of November. The second segment, 8200 South to 3500 South, will be constructed in spring of 2017.

SR-111 will need three full closures from SR-209 to 8200 South as part of this project. The first full closure will take place from 10 p.m. on 9/9 to 6 a.m. on 9/12. During this closure, motorists should use the detour route shown in the map below. Residents in the neighborhood south of 8200 South and west of 6700 West should use 6700 West as the access route to and from the neighborhood. Crews will be completing roadway reconstruction and drainage work during the closure. Flagging operations will resume once SR-111 has reopened.
