

SR-209 to 3500 South

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) will begin a project on SR-111 (Bacchus Highway) from SR-209 (New Bingham Highway) to 3500 South on August 22, 2016. The project will be constructed in two segments. The first segment, SR-209 to 8200 South, will be complete by the end of November. The second segment, 8200 South to 3500 South, will be constructed in spring of 2017. The following improvements are included in this project.

SR-111 IMPROVEMENTS

- Replacing the top layer of asphalt to provide a smoother driving surface
- Replacing drainage features (box culverts) under the roadway
- Widening shoulder areas

Lane restrictions may begin as early as August 22. One travel lane will be maintained with the use of flagging operations at all times except Monday through Friday from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. when one lane in each direction will be maintained to accommodate rush hour traffic. Three weekend full closures of SR-111, between SR-209 and 8200 South, are also anticipated. These closures are tentatively scheduled for September. Motorists are encouraged to use alternate routes, particularly if travel is time-sensitive, to avoid delays. In addition, we ask that truck traffic and cyclists avoid the project area as lanes will be narrowed.
