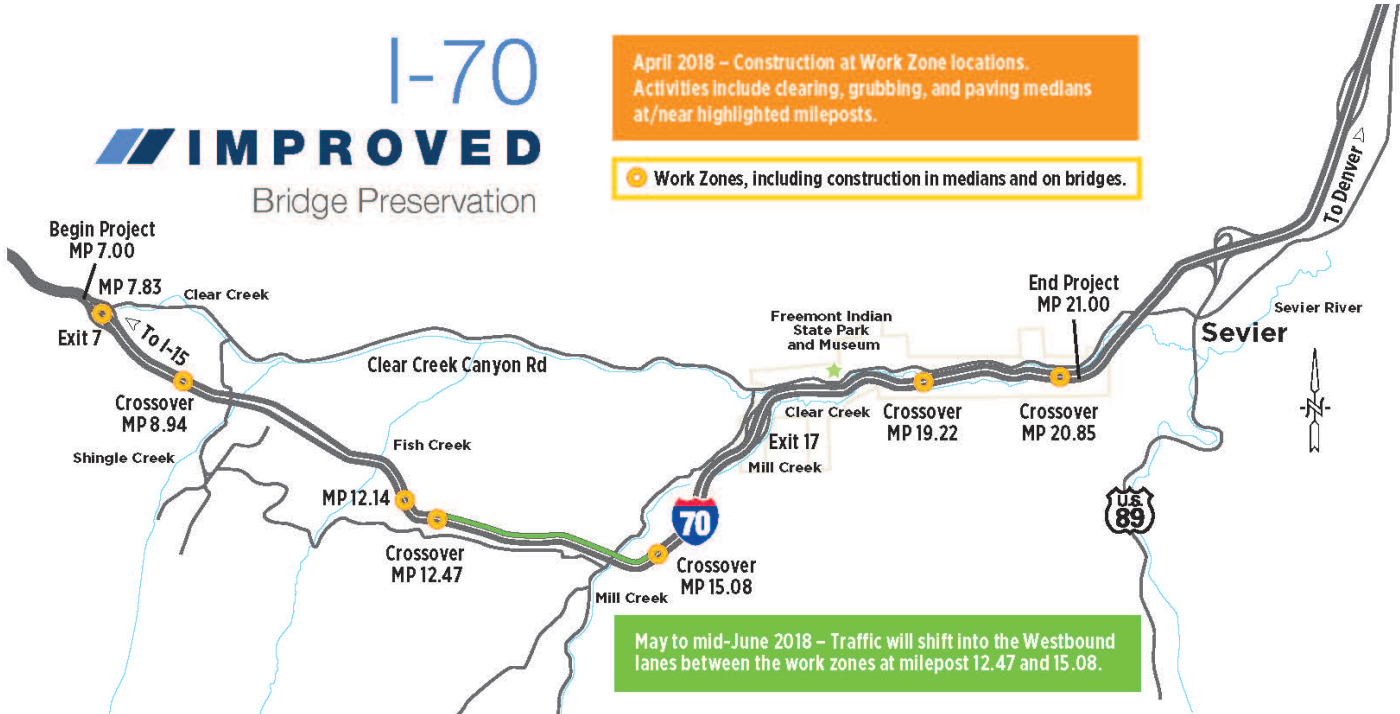

Bridge Preservation

In early April, 2018, the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) will begin construction to remove and reconstruct the driving surface of 14 bridges on Interstate 70 between Cove Fort and Sevier, Utah (mileposts 7 to 21). Using hydro-demolition, the project will remove several inches from the bridge decks while leaving the bridge structure in place. This cost-effective treatment will extend the life of the existing bridge structures while providing an improved driving surface. Work is planned to begin approximately three miles west of Fremont Indian State Park (mile posts 12-15) in early April. The project is on an accelerated schedule to complete in late 2019.

ANTICIPATED IMPACTS

- Traffic on I-70 will be reduced to one lane in each direction and will cross over to one side of I-70 to allow for work on the opposite bridge.
- The speed limit will be reduced and there will be additional construction traffic and equipment on/near the roadway.
- Anticipate traffic congestion and delays. Plan for extra travel time in this area.
- Roads crossing under I-70 in this area may be restricted during reconstruction at individual bridge locations. For your safety, please pay attention to flagger instructions.
