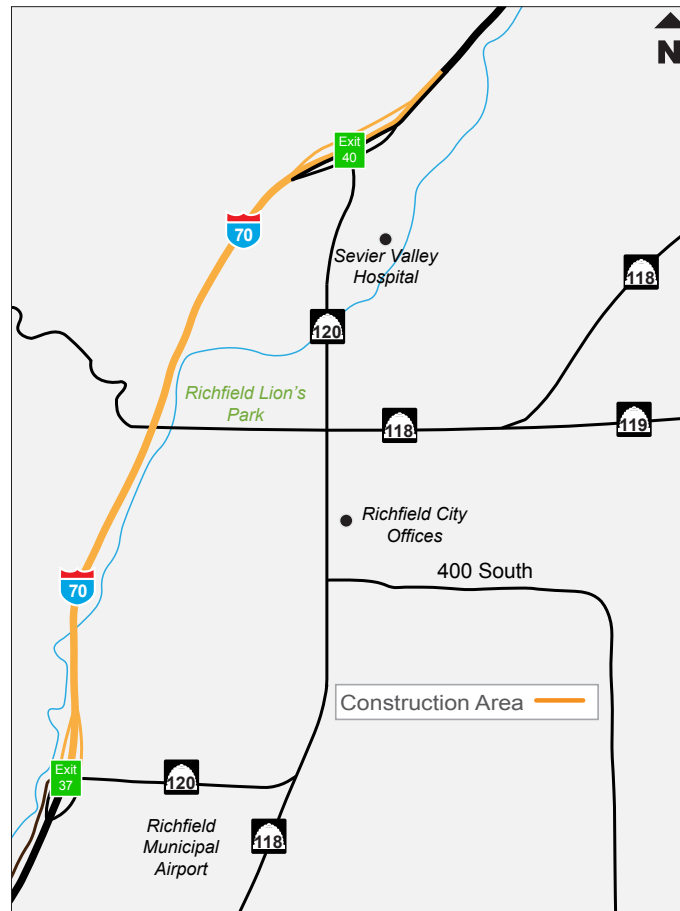


I-70 Pavement Reconstruction

Richfield South to Richfield North (Exits 37-40)



The Utah Department of Transportation will reconstruct the concrete pavement on I-70 from Exit 37 to just beyond Exit 40 in Richfield. Work is scheduled to begin on May 30, and is scheduled for completion in late November. Crews will break up the existing concrete and replace it with new asphalt, providing a smoother ride for drivers and extending the life of the road. The project also includes bridge maintenance, sign replacements, and safety improvements.



DURING CONSTRUCTION

Construction will be limited to daytime hours. Nearby residents and businesses should expect moderate noise during construction due to the machinery used to break up the existing concrete pavement. Drivers should be prepared for lane restrictions and traffic shifts in place 24 hours a day on I-70. Construction crews will shift all traffic onto the westbound lanes of the interstate while they reconstruct the eastbound lanes. Once construction is complete on the eastbound lanes, all traffic will be shifted onto the eastbound lanes so crews can repave the westbound lanes.
