

## **OVERVIEW**

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) will repave SR-193 between Hill Field Road and US-89 this summer. Construction is scheduled to begin in mid-April and continue for approximately three months. Crews will also rebuild pedestrian ramps throughout the project limits to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). This project will extend the life of the roadway and provide a smoother ride for drivers.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

Work will take place Monday through Saturday. For the first two weeks, crews will work between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. In early May, work will shift to overnight hours between 7 p.m. and 7 a.m. for the remainder of the project.

- Drivers should expect lane restrictions within the work zone and plan ahead for minor delays.
- Driveways and accesses throughout project limits will be temporarily affected during asphalt paving.

Please note that construction schedules are weather and equipment-dependent and are subject to change.
