


State Route 256

IMPROVED

Milepost 0 to Milepost 5.6



Pavement rehabilitation work on State Route 256 scheduled to begin on Tuesday, August 30.

This work consists of some asphalt removal of the road surface (approximately one hundred feet in length) at the beginning and ending locations of the project with additional removal at connecting intersections to allow for new asphalt.

The majority of the paving work consists of leveling the existing roadway to smooth the surface, followed by the application of a new layer of asphalt along the entire project length.

Construction work is expected to last approximately two months.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Daytime work, with hours from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. No nighttime work is anticipated.
- Some minor pavement removal with a new layer of pavement added to the roadway.
- Some guardrail replacement work.

IMPACTS

Traffic may be reduced to one lane in work locations, with possible delays of up to fifteen minutes during working hours.

Daytime business access closures (30 minutes maximum per location).

Daytime residential access closure (60 minutes maximum per location).

City street or side street closures (60 minutes maximum per location).
