to Dinosaur National Monument

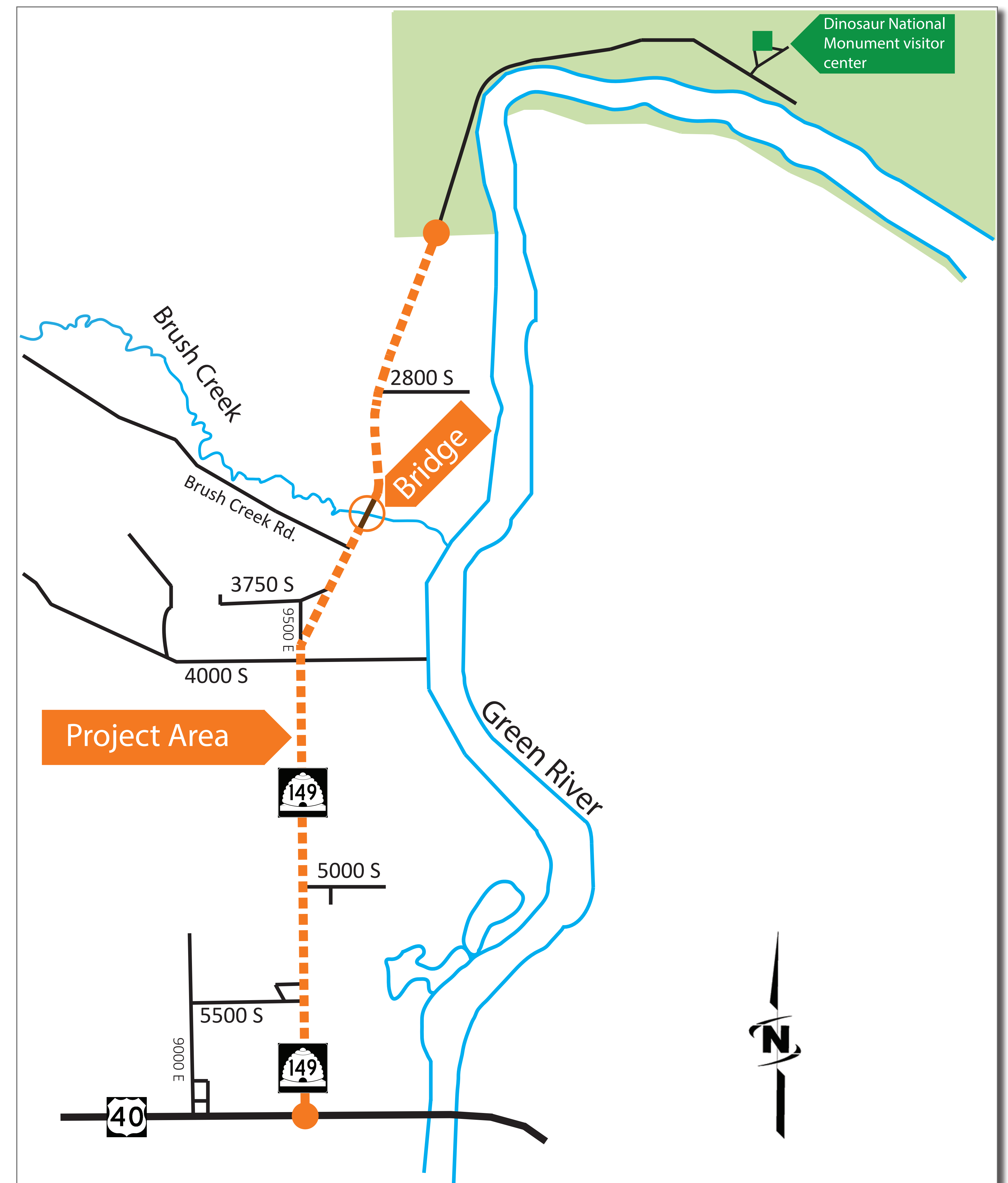


PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) are working together to bring roadway improvements to SR-149.

These improvements include:

- Widened travel lanes
- Widened and improved shoulders
- Replacement of the Brush Creek Bridge



PROJECT BENEFITS

Roadway improvements will:

1 Enhance Safety

- Widen lanes and shoulders to improve safety for drivers and cyclists

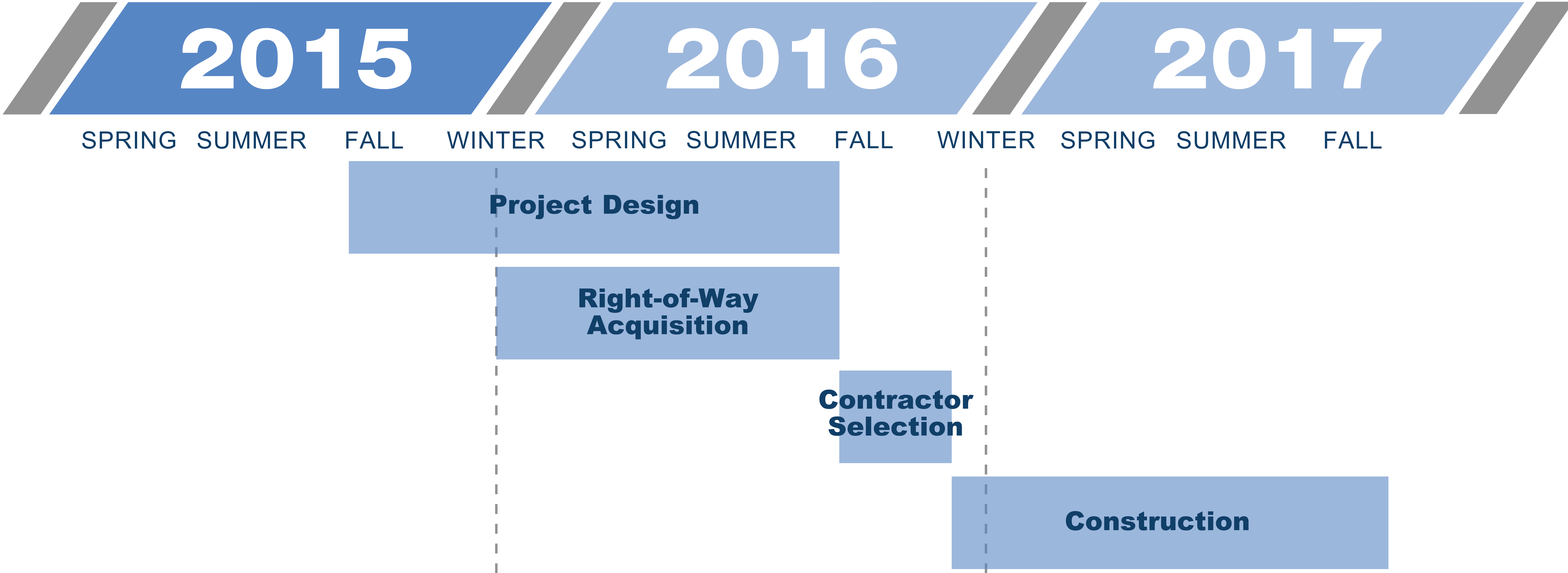
2 Improve Mobility

- Provide 12 foot wide travel lanes in each direction
- Provide 4 foot wide shoulders
- Improve access for other modes of travel

3 Preserve Infrastructure

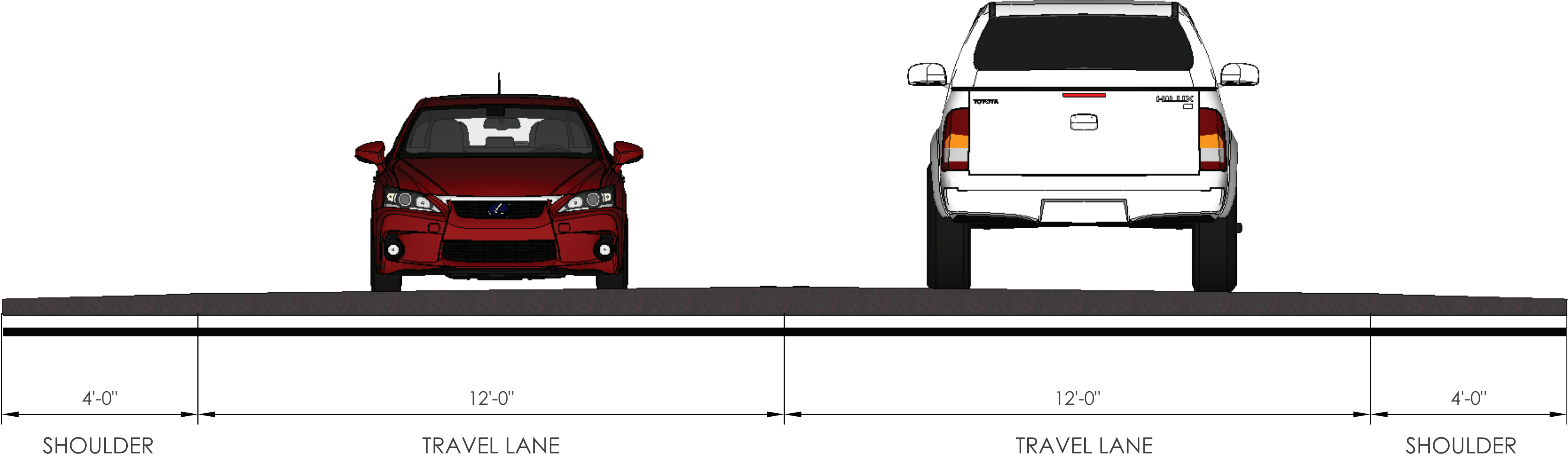
- Resurface existing roadway
- Replace the Brush Creek Bridge

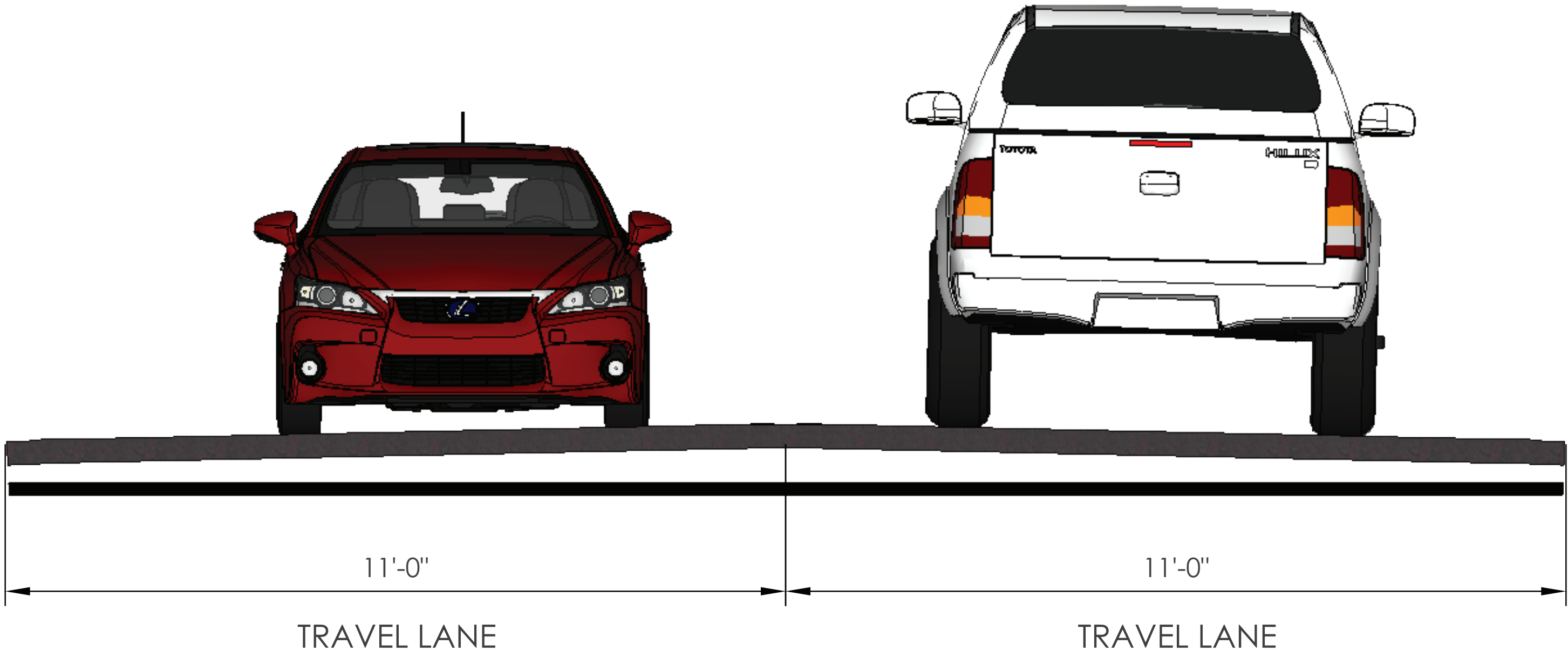

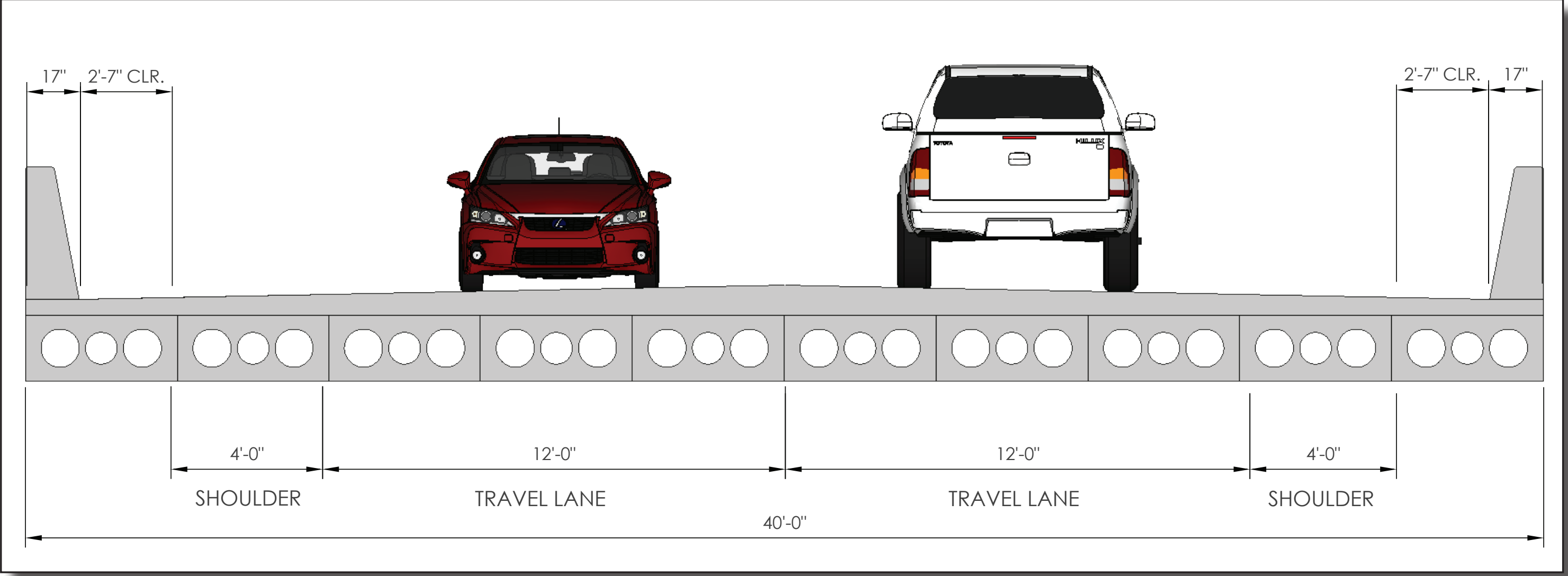
Proposed Roadway

RIGHT-OF-WAY PROCESS

1 Identification

Design team will identify what property is needed to construct the improvements

2 Contact

Property owners will be contacted if their property is in the area identified

3 Valuation

Right-of-way professionals will then estimate the value of property

4 Acquisition

UDOT will work closely with the property owner to acquire the needed property at fair market value
