

UDOT plans to improve the interchange located at I-15 and 9000 South in Sandy City

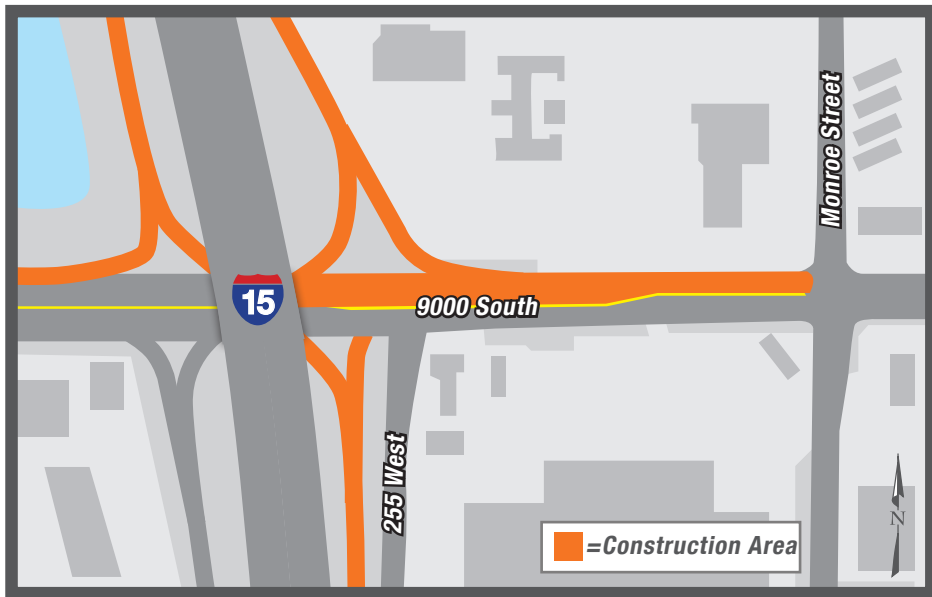
